The program focuses on practical approaches to higher education leadership, student success and development, diversity and inclusion, planning and budgeting, law and policy, and individual and institutional leadership.

Higher Education Leadership Degree Overview

- 30 credits of coursework
- Six-semester program designed with summer and evening coursework for working individual



Admission Requirements

- Verification of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- A cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 or a GPA of 3.0 for the last 60 credits of university coursework
- Three professional references who will provide recommendations through the application portal
- A successful interview with the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Submission of complete graduate application and admissions essay

Continuance and Graduation Requirements

- Complete all program hours (30)
- Complete all courses with a grade of B- or higher
- Maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher

- Successfully complete a graduate project that is accepted by the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Complete courses and project requirements within five years
