The K-12 Educational Leadership emphasis is the best way to get into the principal's office. This program provides educators who have at least three years of successful teaching and leadership experience the opportunity to pursue the coursework and practice required to apply for a Utah State Board of Education (USBE) School Leadership license. Students can complete a full master's degree in six semesters, or, if they already have a master's degree, an administrative certificate in three semesters.

Our program is ideal for working educators and is extremely hands-on. A mix of in-person and livestream courses are offered to allow students maximum flexibility, and coursework mirrors actual administrative work, including extensive interactions with local district leaders and programs. Graduates of our program enjoy a strong start to their career in school leadership, having developed an arsenal of tools they can use to lead their school into a brighter future.

- Three professional letters of recommendation, including one from the direct administrative supervisor
- A successful interview with the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Submission of complete graduate application and admissions essay
