The Teacher Leadership program is designed for practicing teachers who want to enhance their teaching and mentoring at the school, district, and community levels. This emphasis reviews innovative instructional strategies, effective use of assessments for learning, and responsive curriculum design. Teachers will develop a broader understanding of the educational landscape, which will help them advocate for effective and responsible policies for PK-12 education.

Teacher Leadership Degree Overview

- 30 credits of coursework
- Six-semester program designed with summer and evening coursework for working educators

Continuance and Graduation Requirements

- Complete all program hours (30)
- Complete all courses with a grade of B- or higher
- Maintain an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Successfully complete a graduate project that is accepted by the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Complete courses and project requirements within five years

Admission Requirements

- Verification of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- A cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 or a GPA of 3.0 for the last 60 credits of university coursework
- Three professional letters of recommendation
- A successful interview with the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Submission of complete graduate application and admissions essay

The Master of Education in Teacher Leadership does not currently lead to licensure.
