Teacher Leadership Emphasis

The Teacher Leadership program is designed for teachers who want to enhance their teaching and mentoring within the school, district, and community levels. This emphasis reviews innovative instructional strategies, effective use of assessments for learning, and responsive curriculum design. It prepares teachers to mentor, coach, and develop a broader understanding of the educational landscape to advocate for effective and responsible policies for PK-12 education.

This emphasis does not lead to administrative licensure.

Teacher Leadership Degree Overview

- 30 credits of course work
- Six-semester program designed with summer and evening coursework for working educators

Admission Requirements

- Verification of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- A cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 or a GPA of 3.0 for the last 60 credits of university coursework
- A successful interview with the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Three professional letters of recommendation
- Submission of complete graduate application and admissions essay
