- 1) ENGL and MATH QL courses must have a grade C or higher.
- 2) Overall GPA of 3.0 or higher with no grade lower than a C in content area courses.
- 3) Completion of all general education requirements and 70% of content area courses.
- 5) Pass LiveScan Criminal Background Check.

Graduation Requirements

1. Completion of a minimum of 129 semester credits, 40 credits must be upper-division.
2. Overall grade point average of 3.0 (B) or above with no grade lower than a C or better in required major content courses and no grade lower than a B- in licensure and methods courses. MUSC 250R and 450R require a B or higher. MUSC 4220, 4221, 4360, and 4370 courses require a grade B- or higher.
3. Residency hours - minimum of 34 credit hours through course attendance at UVU, with at least 10 hours in the last 45 hours.
4. Completion of GE and specified departmental requirements, including a sophomore review, a 30-minute senior recital, and concert attendance requirements.
5. Successful completion of at least one Global/Intercultural course.
