UVU 2015 Fall Drum Set Auditions

Drum set auditions are held the Friday before classes start at 1p in GT 416.

This audition serves to place students in each ensemble requiring a drum set musician including pep band and all jazz and contemporary ensembles.

You will be asked to demonstrate time and solo in various rock, jazz, and Latin styles. Chart sight-reading will also be requested.

The Drummer's Workbook by Jay Lawrence offers a wealth of knowledge to help prepare for this audition. Spend plenty of time (hours upon hours—regularly) actively studying recordings suggested in each style and follow these audition tips:

- Use a metronome while practicing.
- Play musically—phrasing is not just for pitched instruments.
- Practice slowly.
- Carry yourself with a professional demeanor.
- Set up your instrument in a logically ergonomic fashion and develop relaxed efficient technique.
- Drink plenty of water, eat something healthy (bananas may act as a natural beta blocker to help calm nerves), and sleep well the night before.
