



FACTS ABOUT UVU

EDUCATING UTAH'S WORKFORCE

- 93% of UVU students are Utah residents,
- 77% of alumni still live and work in Utah 10 years after graduation.
- 73% of UVU graduates earn degrees that lead to high-demand,
 4- and 5-star jobs in Utah's economy.
- UVU ranks No. 1 in Utah for producing local entrepreneurs (Switch On Business, 2024).

ACCESS, GROWTH, AND STUDENT SUCCESS

- With an enrollment of 46,809 students (fall 2024), UVU has grown 14.3%
 over the past five years more than any other public university in the state.
- 78% of UVU students work while in school.
- 41% of UVU students are the first in their families to attend college.
- UVU's retention rate has increased 5 percentage points in five years, reaching 70%.
- Because of UVU's unwavering commitment to open enrollment, completion rates have improved 10 percentage points, now at 46%.

CAREER AND ECONOMIC IMPACT

- UVU earned the distinction as an "Opportunity College and University Higher Access, Higher Earnings" by the Carnegie Classification of
 Institutions of Higher Education in Washington, D.C.
- For every dollar invested in UVU, \$8 is returned to the local economy.
- UVU is the third-largest employer in Utah County.
- UVU is ranked the No. 1 best value college in Utah by Research.com (2025).

STRATEGIC REINVESTMENT PROCESS

With an efficiency-focused approach, UVU aims to reduce costs while ensuring flexible, relevant, high-quality education that helps our students succeed in work and life. This includes educating students to meet growing state workforce demands and preparing them to make positive impacts in their communities.

The reallocation process was founded upon several metrics, including enrollment, financial costs and contributions, workforce demand, and UVU's mission. The reinvestment initiatives were strategically crafted to reduce the time required for students to graduate, align educational outcomes with workforce needs, and equip graduates with the essential skills for professional success. A logic model was employed to ensure a systematic approach.

Campus participation included town halls, university shared-governance groups, internal suggestion forms, and intranet and email updates with engaged faculty and staff.




