## HIGH SCHOOL

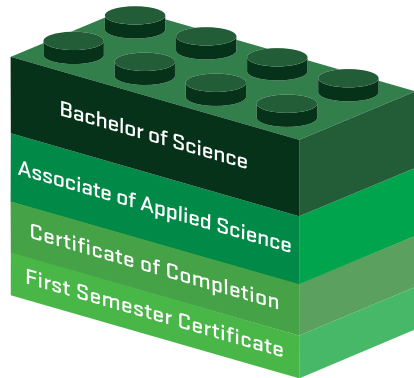

**First Semester Certificate**

**Graduation Requirements:**

1. Completion of a minimum of 15 credits.
2. Overall grade point average of 2.0 (C) or above.
3. Residency hours — minimum of 4 credit hours through course attendance at UVU

If long-range goal is AAS or BS in CMGT, take additional classes to stay on track for a 4-year graduation plan.

**Certificate of Completion**

**Graduation Requirements:**

1. Completion of a minimum of 30 semester credits.
2. Overall grade point average of 2.0 (C) or above.
3. No grade lower than “C-”.
4. Residency hours — minimum of 10 credit hours through course attendance at UVU.

If long-range goal is AAS or BS in CMGT take additional classes to stay on track for a 4-year graduation plan.

**Associate of Applied Science**

**Graduation Requirements:**

1. Completion of a minimum of 63 semester credits.
2. Overall grade point average of 2.0 (C) or above.
3. Residency hours — minimum of 20 credit hours through course attendance at UVU.
4. Complete all core requirements with a minimum grade of “C-” or better.

If long-range goal is BS in CMGT, take classes as outlined to stay on track for a 4-year graduation plan.

**Bachelor of Science**

**Graduation Requirements:**

1. Completion of a minimum of 120 semester hours.
2. A minimum of 40 credits must be upper-division (numbered 3000 or above)
3. Overall grade point average of 2.0 (C) or above.
4. No grade lower than a “C-” in any Discipline Core or Elective course.
5. Completion of GE and specified departmental requirements.
6. Residency hours - Minimum of 30 credit hours through course attendance at UVU, with at least 10 hours earned in the last 45 hours.
7. Successful completion of at least one Global/Intercultural course.
