



### HISTORY OF GRADUATION RATES




### STUDENT HEADCOUNT COMPARISON BY CLASS LEVEL




These are some of the highlights of the last five years:

- Expanding programs and increasing offerings: undergraduate certificates (37 to 46), associate degrees (63 to 67), bachelor's degrees (75 to 90), graduate certificates (2 to 4), master's degrees (3 to 8), minors (52 to 65), & total degree emphases (205 to 224).
- Adding engineering degrees and a department of engineering;
   college name change to the College of Engineering and Technology.
- Expanding the health programs under the new name of the College of Health and Public Service.
- Hiring 310 full-time faculty, taking the total to 730; reaching and passing the goal of 55 percent of all course sections taught by fulltime faculty.
- Increasing the graduation/completions by 20 percent.




### INCREASING UVU'S GRADUATION RATE


