# **1. OVERVIEW, BENCHMARKS, AND METHODOLOGIES**

Policy 640 drafting committee member Nizhone Meza reviewed policy manuals and faculty handbooks at other universities to see how these institutions address sabbatical leaves. Meza's research analyzed other institutions to see if they addressed 12 predetermined benchmarks:

- Eligibility (time until eligible and time in between)
- Compensation
- Benefits
- Where Do Funds Come From?
- Authorization (who and process)
- Levels of Review
- Final Decision
- Determining Distribution with Multiple Applicants
- Post-Sabbatical Reports
- Evaluation
- Obligation to return to University
- Outside employment

45 institutions' policies were analyzed in this research, which includes the following higher-ed schools:

- Utah System of Higher Education (USHE) Institutions (8)
- <u>UVU's Comparable Peer Institutions (IPEDS)</u> (8)
- Carnegie Classification Colleges with a Similar Profile (16)
- Other American Institutions Identified by Nizhone Meza (13)

These comparisons and analysis were documented in <u>an Excel file titled Policy Research</u> <u>Summary.640</u>, which can be found in the Policy 640 Microsoft Teams files.

# **2. KEY FINDINGS**

## Where Policy is Housed or Documented

The analyzed institutions and corresponding policies utilized different content organization strategies (see *Table 1*). Ten institutions had a specific policy for sabbatical leave while eight institutions had a policy encompassing all forms of faculty leave. Eleven institutions addressed sabbatical leave in their faculty handbooks. Eleven other institutions had an official sabbatical leave policy that was outlined in a different form of documentation such as an executive memo or a higher education system contract. The remaining five institutions either had no official policy or no documentation on their sabbatical leave processes.

### **Model Sabbatical Leave Policies**

Eight of the researched institutions addressed at least 75 percent of the benchmarks (see *Table 2*). Should the drafting committee be interested in reviewing other institutional policies to help shape the current Policy 644 draft, these institutions' policies would be the best references discovered during the research process.

### **Details of the Sabbatical Leave Process**

Of the eight public USHE institutions, seven of them—including Utah Valley University—require six years at the appropriate rank to become eligible for sabbatical leave. Many of these institutions require those six years to be consecutive. Six years is also the consensus for institutions outside of Utah as 21 of the remaining 37 researched institutions require six years at the appropriate rank to become eligible.

Of the schools with a known number of levels of review (see *Table 3*), ten different institutions implemented three levels of review, six institutions implemented four levels, and five institutions implemented five levels. The remaining institutions had either six, two, or only one level of review.

The final decision maker varied among the researched institutions, but three options were the most common (see *Table 4*). Fourteen of the schools gave this final decision power to the University President, eight to the Board of Trustees or the Board of Regents, and seven to the Provost (including UVU). Most of the remaining institutions did not specify who had the final decision.

Finally, of the 45 researched institutions, only Utah Valley University and two other schools involved Faculty Senate in the sabbatical leave approval or appeals processes.
