#### 3. Administrative Units

Provost Wayne Vaught presented the plan to create a new Department of Graduate Education in the School of Education; split and delete the Engineering Technology Department in the Smith College of Engineering & Technology by consolidating part into the Transportation Technologies Department to create the Applied Engineering and Transportation Technologies Department and to consolidate part into the Technology Management Department to create the Technology Management and Mechatronics Department; split the Public Health Department (unit remains) in the College of Health and Public Service by creating the Health Sciences Department; and to split the Behavioral Science Department (unit remains) in the College of Humanities and Social Sciences by creating Social and Behavioral Sciences Department, creating the Psychology and Counseling Department and discontinuing the Literacies & Composition Department, and restructure the English & Literature Department to absorb the discontinued unit. Trustee Paul Thompson motioned to approve the administrative units as presented. Trustee Kara North seconded. The motion was carried out without opposition.
