Connecting to the Campus VPN with Cisco AnyConnect

Windows Client

1. Log into the Campus VPN web page.

Log into the Campus VPN web page with your UVID and password at <u>https://</u>

campusvpn.uvu.edu

Note: The Campus VPN web site and VPN will not be available when connected to the UVU campus network.

2. Download the Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client.

On the screen that appears after logging in, click **AnyConnect VPN**. Your computer will download the Cisco AnyConnect application.



3. Launch the Cisco AnyConnect application.

When the application finishes downloading, launch the application by clicking it's icon.



Click the icon that starts with **anyconnect-win** to launch the installer.

4. Install Cisco AnyConnect.

Follow the prompts to install Cisco AnyConnect. When the installation is finished, close the installer.



5. Launch the VPN Client to connect to the VPN.

Open the Start Menu by clicking it's icon in the bottom left.

Near the top, you will see an icon for the Cisco AnyConnect application. Click the **Cisco AnyConnect** icon to launch the Cisco AnyConnect Mobility Client.



6. Connect to the Campus VPN.

Once the Cisco AnyConnect Mobility Client has been opened, enter **campusvpn.uvu.edu** in the field provided and click **Connect**.

Note: The Campus VPN will not be available while connected to the UVU campus network.
