Fellows for the Environment



The newly created **Environmental Initiatives Hub** at the Center for Social Impact is pleased to announce a call for **Fellows for Utah's Environment**. Fellows will design curriculum and learning materials on local environmental issues that will be distributed across campus and to local Utah County school districts. Fellows will start in early Spring 2022 with all materials completed by July 1, 2022. These fellowships are part of the Civic Thought and Leadership Program grant made to UVU by the Utah Legislature. If selected as a fellow, you will participate in training on environmental policy, environmental citizenship, the legislative process, as well as have the opportunity to meet with elected representatives. Faculty Fellows will also be asked to develop course materials, activities, and learning modules on environmental citizenship and literacy to be used in classes across campus.

Fellows will receive a stipend of \$2000.

1. What is your academic background?
2. What is your experience and/or interest in environmental issues in Utah?
3. What does Environmental Citizenship mean to you?
4. Why is it important to develop environment literacy across campus?
