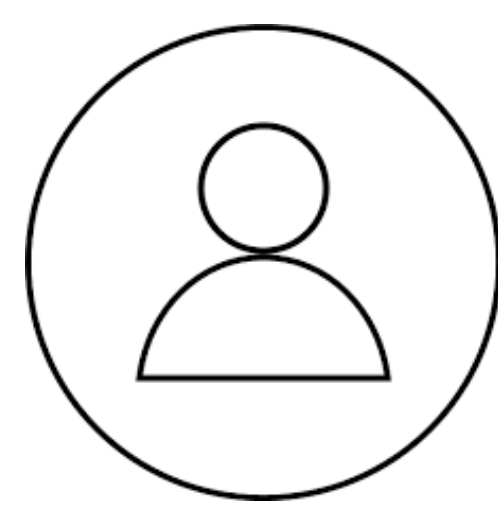

Lives In: West Jordan, UT

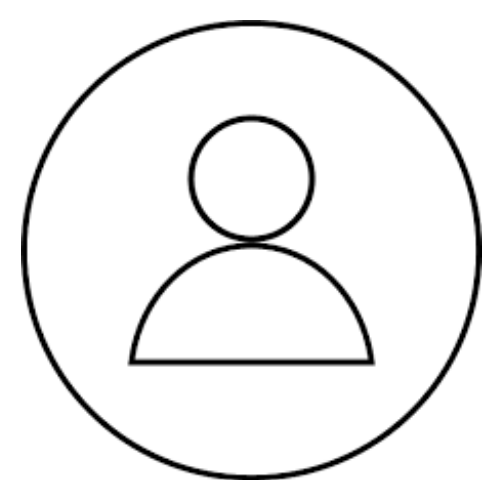
Her Story:
