PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS & STUDENT SUCCESS

- 19,331 First-Gen students enrolled at UVU, comprising 41% of the student population
- 3,587 first gen students graduated in Spring 2024
- Awarded \$208,051 in scholarships to first-gen students
- Launched 3 mentorship programs, focusing on college success, career readiness, and academic support
- Hosted 58 events in or connected to our center, reaching a total of 6,213 students or more
- Increased participation in National First Generation College Student Week by 11,700 percent from 2023 to 2024. (13 participants in 2023 to 1,534 in 2024)
- Facilitated 230+ student success coaching appointments.

2025-2026 GOALS

- Connect with academic departments to embed first-gen supports in courses during the first week of classes.
- Reach 10,000 students through first-gen events, workshops, activities, and student appointments.
- Expand the peer mentoring program, dedicated to success coaching, student training, and improved college navigation by conducting 250 individual student appointments and 20 student engagement events.
- Connect with 3-5 new prospective donors.
- Create a robust social media presence, providing a platform for students to be informed and engaged with the First Gen Center
- Create an event and center check in system that allows us to verify first-gen status and better assess the effectiveness of projects, activities, and events.
