- The program now offers the GEAR UP Utah Scholarship to all eligible students
- The program sent 6 school district personnel from Alpine and SLC to the NCCEP's District Leadership Institute




PROGRAM YEARLY OBJECTIVES

- Increase GU students and their families' knowledge of post-secondary education options, preparation and financing.


2025-26 STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

FIRST GENERATION STUDENTS SERVED




HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION RATE




