We give direction, support, encouragement, and provide students with tools to think critically and learn from adversity.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

The Office of Student Rights & Accountability promotes student learning, accountability, and success by addressing conduct concerns through an educational and developmental approach. Rather than focusing solely on policy violations, the office equips students with the tools and support needed to learn from challenges, make informed decisions, and successfully navigate their university experience. Interventions are tailored to each student's circumstances and may include educational meetings, conduct warnings, behavior agreements, mutual no-contact directives, restorative remedies, restrictions, or other individualized responses that foster accountability, personal growth, and long-term success.

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Investigate and resolve alleged violations of the Student Code of Conduct, including academic integrity, classroom disruptions, and behavioral misconduct. Protect students' due process rights while promoting accountability, learning, and personal growth. In accordance with UVU Policy 541, the Student Conduct Office utilizes a balanced approach that encourages student success through four key intervention strategies:

- **Accountability** – Assign fair, proportionate, and educational sanctions that hold students accountable for their behavior, reinforce community expectations, and encourage responsible decision-making.
- **Educational Outcomes** – Designed to promote learning, increase understanding of university expectations, and prevent future misconduct.
- **Reflective Outcomes** – Complete a project, activity, or workshop that encourages self-reflection and consideration of the impact one's behavior has on themselves and others.
- **Restorative Outcomes** – Complete a project, activity, or workshop that addresses the impact of misconduct and works to repair harm caused to individuals or the university community.

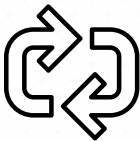
