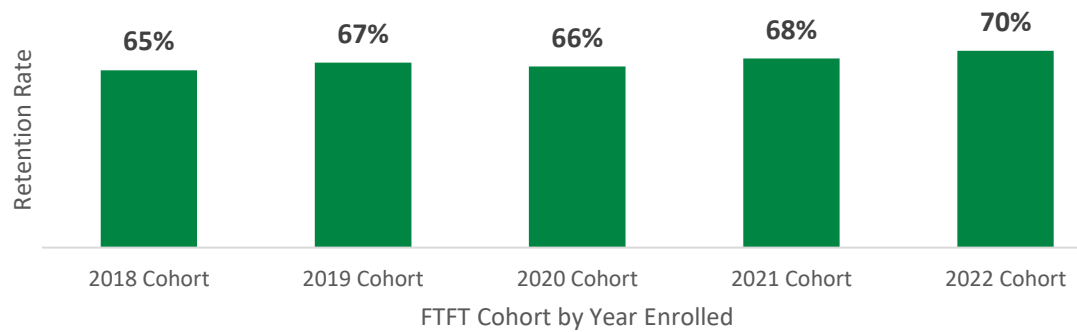

# Cohort Retention Analysis

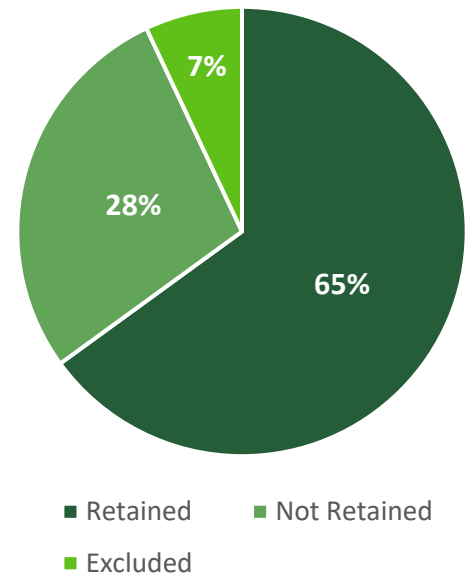


5-year average retention rate of: 67.01%

The raw Fall 2022 first-time, full-time, bachelor's degree seeking cohort consisted of 1,913 students. This was an increase of 215 students from the count of 1,698 students from Fall 2021.

Within this cohort 21%, or 362 students, identified as Black, Indigenous, Person of Color (BIPOC). This representation is consistent with prior cohorts.

In the Fall 2023 semester 1,238 students from this cohort returned to UVU with a count of 539 students not being retained. Exclusions were provided for 136 students. Of these exclusions, 125 were for religious service, 9 were for military service, and 2 for foreign service.



### Peer Comparison:

Average retention rate of selected comparable regional institutions through IPEDS reporting. The average retention rate for the selected peer institutions have remained steady near 68% while UVU's rate has shown a trajectory of continual improvement. **Due to the nature of IPEDS reporting, peer comparison is one cohort behind internally reported data.**
