## LEARNING OUTCOMES

To accomplish this mission, the UVU Veteran Success Center advocates for the military community by providing opportunities for comradery and mentorship. VSC staff are experts on federal and state education funding programs that assist with:

- Utilizing education benefits
- Navigating the higher education system and Individual Education Plans (IEPs)
- Creating a community of educated veterans
- Accessing veteran and military-connected resources

## PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

- Military-Connected Orientation: Online orientation specific to veterans, military spouses, and military dependent children that introduces the Veteran Success Center and the basics of their VA education benefits
- VA Work Study Program: Dozens of enrolled student positions provided through VA funding at no cost to UVU. Helps work studies develop customer service skills, knowledge of VA programs, and opens opportunities for career growth.
- Campus Support: The VSC provides a quiet place for military-connected students to relax, do homework, and escape the chaos of a college campus. Center employees also serve as a one-stop shop to help answer any questions affecting their student accounts and provide resources.
- Veteran Success Scholarship: Qualifying veterans and military-connected students are eligible for merit-based and needs-based financial aid.
- Semester Wellness Checks: Peer-to-peer engagement to inquire about student well-being and assist them on the path to graduation. Connect students to resources and ensure benefits are taken advantage of.
- Graduation Recognition: Specific regalia for veterans, spouses, and dependent children.
- Veterans Day Events: Planned events throughout the week of Veterans Day to recognize and show UVU's support for the service and sacrifice of our military-connected students, staff, and faculty.
- Tuition Assistance Modernization: Updated center training and processes to allow Army reservists/guard members to request and receive pay through new Tuition Assistance systems.

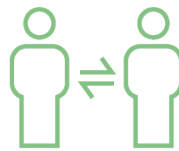
