Housing & Residence Life

Purpose/Mission

Our mission is to create an authentic campus life experience, connecting students to campus resources and promoting a strong affinity with UVU through vibrant and engaging events and activities at partner housing complexes. We also foster student involvement in social, educational, service, recreational, and leadership opportunities.

Learning Outcomes

Housing & Residence Life accomplishes its mission through its Community Leadership Program, in collaboration with the leadership of the housing complexes. Community Leaders are embedded within partner complexes and create events designed to foster a sense of community and involvement. We create learning opportunities for community leaders to grow and develop as individuals while working with their peers, staff, faculty, and community professionals. Because students engage with our department, they will:

- Feel a sense of community and belonging as we create a welcoming and inclusive environment. Strengthen bonds within the university community and participate in activities that validate their lived experiences and foster social connections.
- Experience academic and personal growth by taking risks and learning from failure in a "brave space." Build resilience and coping skills through monthly reflections and goal-setting with program directors and team members.
- Develop personal and leadership skills, including delegation, collaboration, and conflict resolution. Build
 confidence in public speaking, group facilitation, and event planning. Additionally, enhance professional
 competencies, such as resume writing, cover letter development, and requesting letters of
 recommendation.

Programs and Services

Housing & Residence Life assists students in having a positive living experience by facilitating on-site residence life events/activities hosted by community leaders in the following programs:

- Freshman Community Leaders (FCL): Are trained in the Momentum Year framework and develop
 programming specifically aimed at helping first-year students stay at UVU. Their programming includes
 one on-site event and one walk-over event each month. They focus on building peer mentoring
 relationships with first-year students. Currently, the FCL program operates in three of our partner
 complexes.
- Residential Community Leaders (RCL): Live onsite with our Orem-based partner complexes. They host
 two events each month focused on campus resources, building community, creating experiences, or
 reaching niche populations.
- Wolverine Community Leaders (WCL): Are assigned to our Provo-based partner complexes without being required to live onsite. They host one event each month focused on campus resources, building community, creating experiences, or reaching niche populations.

Additionally, we provide or connect students to housing-related resources and information, including housing laws, independent living tutorials, contract navigation assistance, and campus offices and resources


