Registration

It is imperative that you follow your graduation plan very closely when it comes time to register for classes. If you do not register for the correct classes at the correct times, we cannot guarantee that there will be room for you in a future semester. For this reason, **if you fail to register correctly**, **you will be encouraged to switch to the BA**, which has similar classes but more flexibility. Advising sheets and registration numbers can be obtained from your advisor, Brianna Larson.

Progress in the Program

In any given semester, if you receive a <u>C- or below</u> in a BFA course, there are concrete consequences:

- 1. Almost all classes are prerequisites for others, so it is likely you will not be able to register for next semester's courses.
- You will need to meet with the full BFA faculty committee to decide <u>when and if</u> you can retake the class.
 This can extend your time to graduation by a semester to several years, depending on class availability and frequency, and what it is a prerequisite for.
 - c. You may not be able to take the course with core BFA faculty.
 - d. You will not be able to take the course until it is offered again <u>and</u> has an opening. The current BFA class will have priority for registration.

If you find yourself in this position, **you will be encouraged to switch to the BA**, which has similar classes but more flexibility.

To avoid this, make sure to pass all classes with a **C** or above.

Attendance

Department Policy states that a student may accrue a maximum of four absences in a course. If a student has five or more absences in a term, the student cannot pass the course.

Tardiness: UVU BFA courses will follow a strict Closed Door policy. The door will be closed at the beginning of class. Once the door to the classroom is closed you will not be allowed in class for that day, resulting in an absence.
