#### Graduation Requirements

1. Completion of a minimum of 125 semester credits, 40 of which must be upper division.
2. Overall GPA of 3.0 (B) or above with no grade lower than a C in major required content courses and no grade lower than a B- in Licensure and Methods
3. Residency hours - minimum of 30 credit hours through course attendance at UVU, with at least 10 hours in the last 45 hours.
4. Successful completion of at least one Global/Intercultural course.

#### Sophomore Year Progression Requirements

To Register for Upper Division Courses in your Sophomore Year, you **MUST** meet University Advanced Standing Requirement of

- 1) Completed with Math Requirement
- 2) Completed with English 2010, 3) Completed at least 24 credits and
- 4) GPA of 2.0 or higher

#### Summer Semester

In order to maintain your position in the BFA Cohort, it is highly recommended you take General Education courses in the Summer Semester. This will allow you to maintain the focus needed on your professional development and progression in Theatre courses during Fall and Spring semesters.
