

	<h3>Preparation/Motivation</h3> <p>A common activity at large-scale fire or rescue incidents is to use ropes to haul various pieces of equipment from one elevation to another. Proper knots and securing procedures must be used to prevent dropping the equipment.</p> <p>Condition: Wearing firefighter gloves, given a fire axe or pike pole and a length of rope</p> <p>Behavior: The participant will tie the correct knot for hoisting</p> <p>Standard: 1 Minute</p>

 	<h3>Presentation</h3> <p>Select the correct tool</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Whichever tool that needs to be hoisted <p>Select the correct length of rope</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Long enough to reach between elevations <p>Tie the correct knot for hoisting</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Use Clove hitch around the head of the axe and at least one half hitch around the handle 2. Use clove hitch around the handle of the pike pole and two half hitches (one around the pike) 	<p><u>Identify any safety considerations pertinent to this skill.</u></p>

Hoisting a Fire Axe

Behavioral Objective
