Background

The Office for Global Engagement (OGE) is a unit on the campus of Utah Valley University that strives to assist faculty, students, and staff in developing and maintaining strong international and multicultural relationships. On Tuesday, October 24th, 2017 OGE will hold an informational fair in celebration of United Nations Day. The United Nations is an intergovernmental organization founded in 1945, and is currently made up of 193 Member States. The Mission and work of the United Nations are guided by the purposes and principles contained in its founding charter.

Utah Valley University is currently pursuing associate member status with the United Nations Department of Public Information. This is the culmination of many years of work with partners at Utah Valley University and outside of the institution at the global level.

The United Nations adopted 17 sustainable development goals (SDGs) with 169 targets among them, as a roadmap for promoting human progress around the world in September 2015. Since Utah has been seen as one of the models of sustainable mountain development (SMD), UVU has taken that recognition both to raise awareness about SMD agenda of the UN in State of Utah and North America and to contribute to the adoption and implementation of mountain targets among SDGs. And it is the mission of the Utah International Mountain Forum (UIMF), a coalition of student clubs at UVU to understand and work towards the implementation of goals and in particular mountain targets, that affect Utah.

During an informational fair on Tuesday, October 24th, 2017 UIMF members will share with the participants of the gathering and the audience at UVU:

- Major goals of the UIMF and benefits provided for its student members through student engaged learning initiative with focus on the advocacy of the SMD agenda of the UN in the state of Utah and globally since 2006, when UVU joined the United Nations Mountain Partnership, a facilitator of the SMD agenda globally;
- 2) Major initiatives undertaken by student coalition to advocate the adoption of mountain targets among SDGs during 2013-2015;
