Mental health: Three options

FTE Therapist (SHS needs to hire 2 in the next 2 years per UVU Inclusion plan) \$125,288 (\$2.25)



FTE Crisis Therapist (these are our frontline mental health positions; we are seeing greater volume than we ever have before) \$125,288 (\$2.25)



Fund TimelyCare (funded through 2025, valuable Mental Health program that increases access) \$140,000 (\$2.51)
