



POVERTY AMONG UTAH WOMEN

Poverty is a serious problem for thousands of Utah women.




However, there has been a 2.4% decrease in poverty in Utah since 2016.

US Women in Poverty




Utah Women in Poverty

Rural Counties






Counties with highest female poverty rates:


