VETERANS TUITION GAP PROGRAM

The Veterans Tuition GAP Program is a State supplemental grant to provide tuition assistance for veterans who are recipients of Federal Chapter 1606, 30, 31, 32, 33 Veterans Educational Assistance Act benefits whose benefits have been exhausted or are not available. This award covers the cost of tuition only.

In order to qualify for this grant you must:

- Have received Chapter 1606, 30, 31, 32, 33 Veterans Educational Assistance benefits. (Transfer of Entitlement recipients are not eligible.)
- Have maximized your Veterans Educational Assistance.
- Be a resident student of Utah as defined by Section 53B-8-102.
- Have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with UVU's school code (004027).
- Be accepted and enrolled at UVU in a program leading to a bachelor's degree.
- Not have completed a bachelor's degree.
- Be in your final year of your baccalaureate program as shown on a Wolverine Track Plan.
 - Students are eligible for a maximum of 12 months from the time they initially receive the Veterans Tuition Gap funding, or until they graduate with their bachelor's degree, whichever is earlier.
- Be enrolled at UVU at least half-time.
- Be maintaining satisfactory academic progress:
 - Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0.
 - Must complete 67% of all credit hours attempted.
 - May receive aid for a maximum of 150% of the published length of educational program.
- Have unmet need per federal financial aid policies.
- Provide proof of military service (DD214, NGB-22, etc.)

If you feel you may qualify for this grant, you may sign and submit this form to the Veterans Office located in the Woodbury Business building (WB) room 100a.
