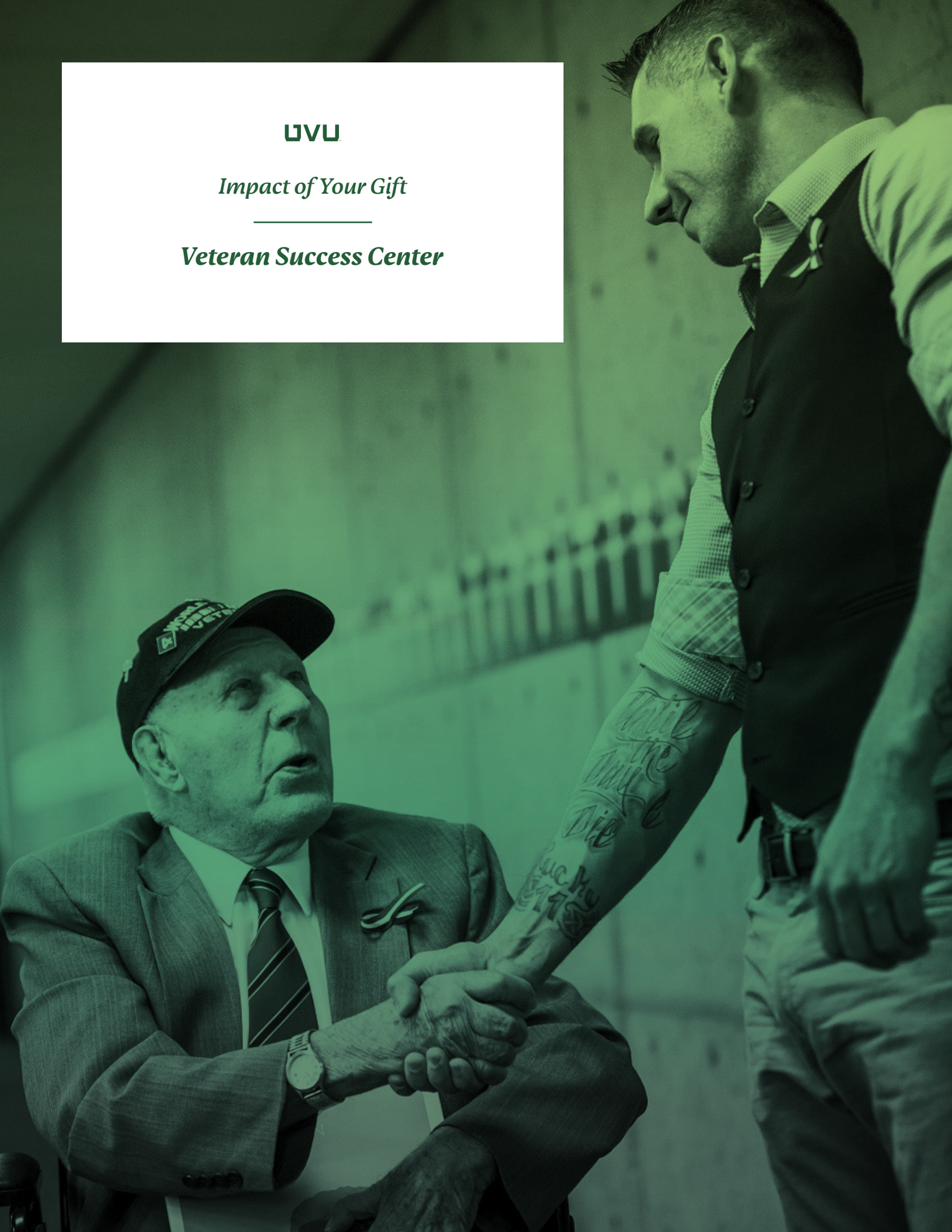

the campaign for **UVU**

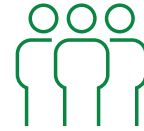
