- Website ownership and structure
- How do we keep the site up-to-date?
  - Many areas of our sites are out of date
  - Size of UVU public site – 298 sites, 29,750 pages
- Web Governanace
  - UCC – deals with policies
  - SWAT – representation from across campus, how can SWAT help you?
    - WDS and Marketing implement
- Department site governance
  - University Division admin owners for areas of campus
  - Web stewards (new assignment, not new positions)
  - Admin owners will determine web stewards
- Accountability
  - Content audit by SWAT
  - Page update procedure
    - Site owners are accountable to web stewards, stewards are accountable to admin owners, SWAT acts as “double check”
- Training Options
  - Training sessions, tutorials
- Purpose-based architecture
  - Determining website purpose and focus
  - Identifying the site’s audience (primary and secondary)
  - Identify goals
  - Identify key actions
  - Build the site around actions
  - Standardize key elements
- Web Stewards
  - Should update content now (don’t wait for the new template)
  - Must attend Web Community Meetings
- Updating Content
  - Check links, especially during site transition
  - Check that links to files (PDF, PPT, DOC, etc.) are up-to-date
  - Keep keywords, meta information up-to-date
  - Check headings, navigation
- Questions: Run accessibility checks to make sure our sites are 508 compliant.
