 - 1. About You: Put as much info. as possible for guests to view
 - 2. What is Content?: text, inks, images, videos, sliders, logo, contact info., description, mission, hours, sales pitch, documents, presentations
 - 3. Make Friends: Campaign, contest, advertising
 - 4. Make Sure Your Friends Like You ©: Must be a two way relationship
 - Do not promote all the time
 - Encourage giving and taking
 - Do not be overbearing
 - Do not be a doormat
 - 5. Be a Good Friend:
 - Relavent
 - Interesting
 - Authentic
 - Consistent-content, voice, interests, frequency, goals, interaction
