Web Accessibilities

- There have been a number of legal cases regarding accessibility issues they look for policies and plans for improvement
- Some of the disabilities that need to be addressed are: Deaf, blind, color blind
- It was suggested that everyone view a screen reader one and to see the limitations
- Accessible forms (in pdf form) are not readable on screen readers lines need to be tab accessible

- Each division needs to police their sites
- Discussion regarding starting "from this time forward" regarding past minutes, agendas, etc.
- Should remember that web accessibility is the right thing to do

- Campus Wide Accessible Committee looks at all angles for accessibilities
- uvu.edu/web/accessibility/index.html needs to be reviewed learn from it and give Nathan feedback
