1. Online Application for Admission to the Secondary Education Teacher Program
2. Successful completion of all General Education requirements and the MAJORITY (70-80%) of content area courses verified by the content area advisor.
3. GE English, Math, Content courses: Pass ENGL 2010 with a "C" or higher, Math QL and Content courses with a "C" or higher.
4. Student Conduct: Must be in good standing with the University.
5. GPA 3.0 or higher (by the application deadline)
6. LiveScan Background Check: Must pass a background check required by the Utah State Board of Education (USBE). LiveScan Fingerprint Receipt Form must be uploaded with program application. Instructions and form found at this link:
